<u>2012 Young Hero Award – Sunday 12:55pm / Honda Blue Cavern Patricia Cosulich</u>

Patricia Cosulich is a sixteen-year-old honors student in the Academy of the Performing Arts at Huntington Beach High School. She is also active in the Girl Scouts and recently began work on her Girl Scout Gold Award project, which represents the highest achievement in the Girl Scouts program. For this project, Patricia selected a cause that is very important to the Aquarium: kelp conservation. Nearly 90 percent of the kelp beds in the ocean off the coasts of Orange County have been lost over the last thirty years because of overfishing and pollution. Through her Help the Kelp campaign, Patricia aims to raise awareness, foster a greater appreciation for the ocean, and inspire the rest of the community to help the cause. She held an open house at her school to kick off the campaign and hopes to establish an annual Help the Kelp Day in Laguna Beach. Her other volunteer efforts include collecting donations to distribute Girl Scout cookies to patients at the Long Beach Veteran's Affairs Hospital for the past four years, and organizing fundraisers for the Children's Hospital of Orange County and another benefitting children orphaned by HIV AIDS in Africa for two years running.
