HOW TO REGISTER



Apply to OCC as a Current High School Student under **Standard Dual Enrollment** (free to apply)

- Processing usually takes 2-3 business days
- You will be given an OCC ID and OCC Email you will need to use for your Dual Enrollment Form

- Title your email subject line: Ocean Course
- Form requires both handwritten parent <u>and</u> high school principal or counselor signatures (Make sure to get these signatures before the school year ends to avoid a delay in processing!)
- Submit the form as soon as possible, limited seats available

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Open to all high school students through the Standard OCC Dual Enrollment Program
- Students will receive college credits and transcript directly from OCC
- You are required to attend class Tuesday evenings at the Aguarium and Thursday evenings by Zoom
- You are responsible for OCC student services fees once you are enrolled in the class (\$54)
- You are responsible for your own transportation to the Aquarium
- Parking costs \$8/day at the Aquarium. HS students can submit a form for parking reimbursement.
